SO, WHAT CAN I EXPECT

The Father & Son Outdoor Retreat is held on Face Lake which is located north of Merritt on the way to Logan Lake. Accommodations have been booked at the beautiful Mile High Lodge. The retreat begins Friday evening with most people arriving between 5 pm and 8 pm. The retreat ends Sunday morning with people leaving the lodge to head home before 11 am.

ACCOMMODATIONS

A number of cabins have been secured for this year's retreat. Space is limited and booked on a first come, first served basis. Please register early to avoid disappointment.

Each cabin has different bedding capacity from 6 to 10 individuals and will be assigned based on the total number within your group.
