



TO ALL FAMILIES,

We are so excited to be running kids camps here at our Walnut Grove campus in August this year! We cannot wait to spend some time with your children as we play games, hear stories, and have fun, all while operating within a framework that is appropriate in light of the evolving Covid-19 pandemic. This page will serve as a starting point for some FAQs we predict you may have.

#### FAQ ABOUT ON SITE SUMMER CAMP

**1. How much will it cost?**

Camps will cost \$40 per child.

**2. When will camp be running?**

Camp will be running the weeks of August 4-7 (MORNING ONLY), 10-13 and 17-20.

**3. How will you run these camps?**

We will be offering two camp programs, one in the morning (9:00-11:30am) and one in the afternoon (1:00-3:30pm). We will be welcoming a total of 60 children per program, and each program will be split into two groups of 30 children that will not come in contact with each other. Each group will be dropped off and picked up in different areas of the church and have separate spaces and bathrooms within the church.

**4. Is camp open to all ages?**

Camp will be open to children finishing Kindergarten-Grade 5 currently (in 2020). Each session will be open to children from those grades, and the children will be split up into age-appropriate groups

**5. Can I register for more than one session of camp?**

No. You will only be able to register for one week of camp so that we can welcome as many children to our camps as possible.

**6. Let's talk logistics. How will this work?**

We will be spending as much time as we can outside, and will be moving as many parts of camp to a format that is accessible outside. That being said, we still will be moving to large spaces inside for specific parts of morning or afternoon of camp, specifically to participate in an opening session that involves music and a story.

**7. When does registration open?**

Registration for all camp weeks will open on Tuesday, June 30 at 9:00am.

**8. So what happened to MOVE camp?**

We recognize that this year will look a lot different than past years, so we made the decision to 'move' away from MOVE as we have known it as we facilitate half-day camps

that will have 60 children per session. The vision and the mission of camp ministry here at NLCC has not changed! Just the way that we will be delivering it this year.

**9. Will I need to sign a waiver?**
